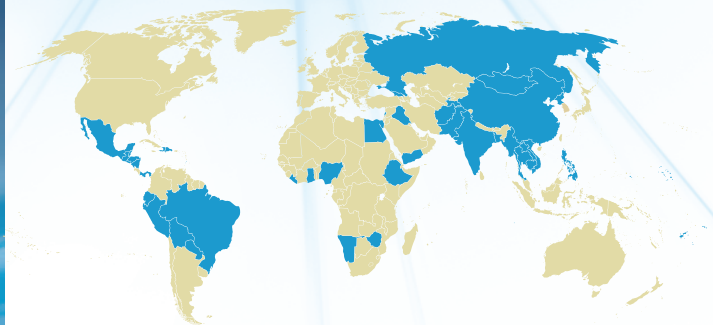


RESTORING SIGHT. TRANSFORMING LIVES.
